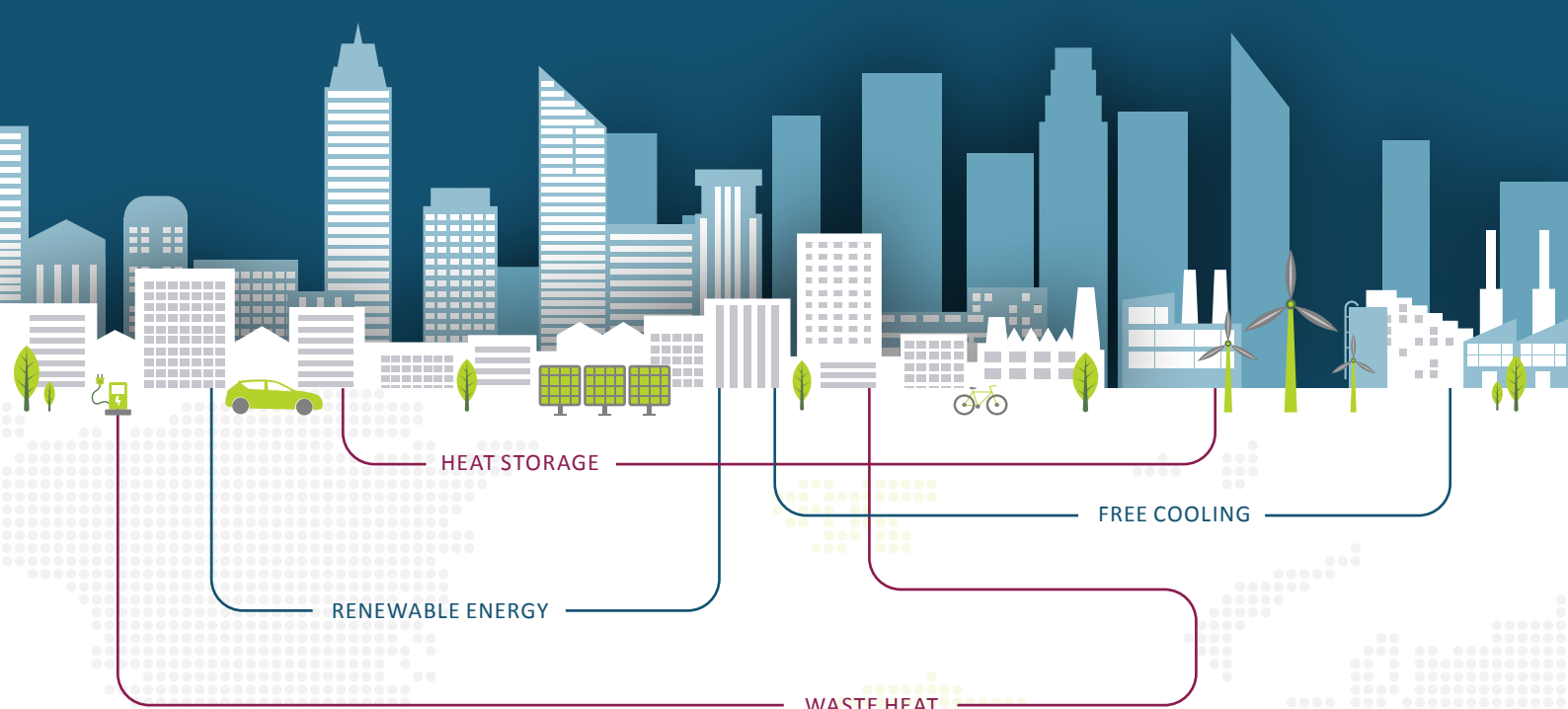
WHAT IS #DHCities?
